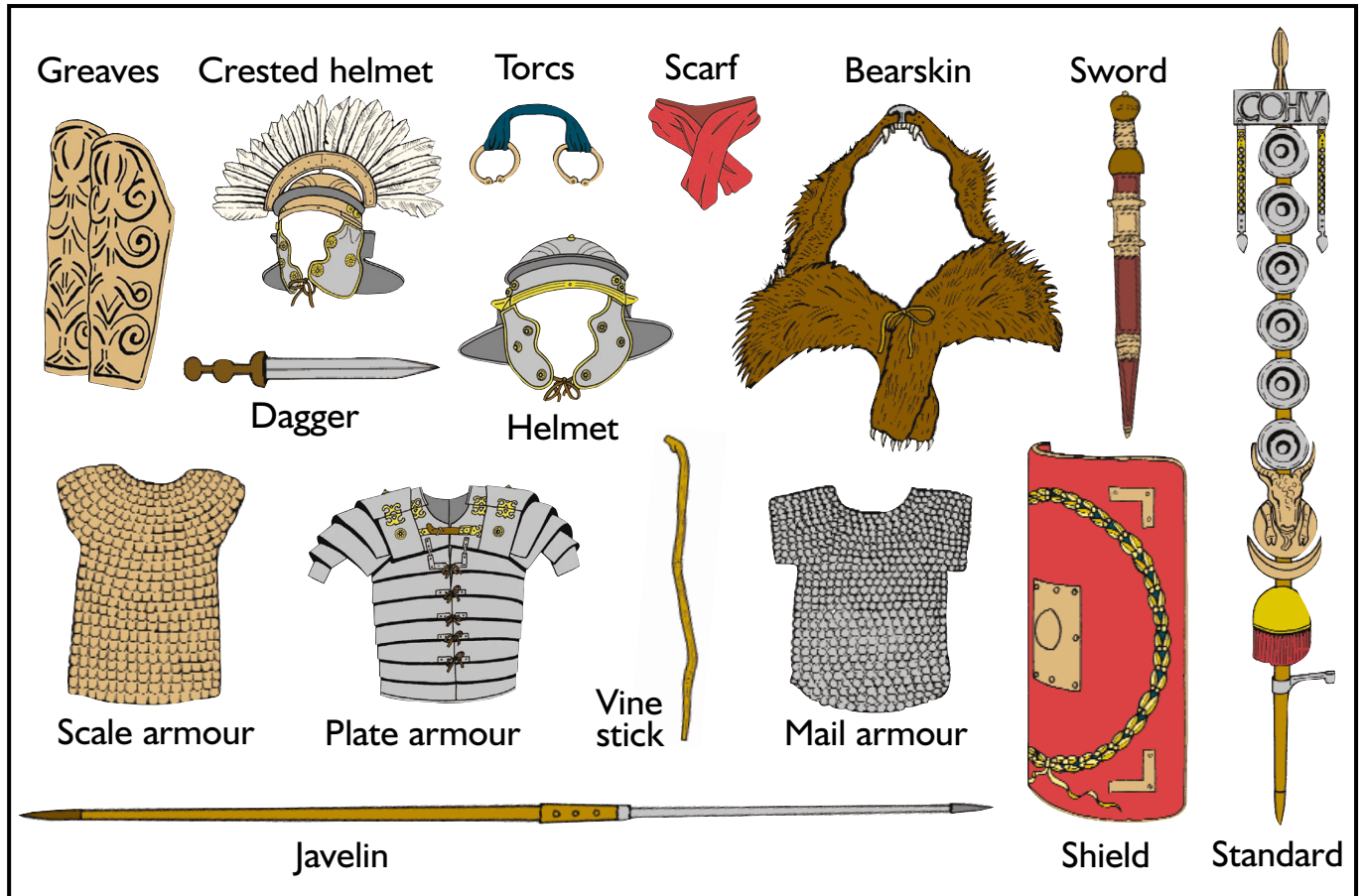


ROMAN SOLDIERS
