Brief description:

Facilitated activity:

This fun interactive 1 hour session gives pupils an insight into the origins of Victorian Christmas and Welsh customs. Pupils will meet the wife of a Swansea ship owner; Eliza Richardson and help decorate a traditional Christmas tree. Pupils will experience the sights and smells of a Victorian Christmas in Wales.

Teacher-led Activity: During this 1 hour teacher-led craft activity pupils will have the opportunity to make their own Victorian style Christmas decoration. This will include an orange and clove pomander, paper chains and a cornucopia.
