






The investigation...

Since October 2005, school scientists across Wales have been keeping weather records and noting when their flowers open, as part of a long-term study looking at the effects of temperature on spring bulbs.








Edina Trust

We continue to work in partnership with The Edina Trust who provide funding and support for the project and have extended its reach to schools in England, Scotland and Northern Ireland!

7,442 pupils took part this year!

Participating schools planted daffodil and crocus bulbs in October and took weather readings from November to March. They entered their weekly weather records and the flowering dates and heights of their plants to the Amgueddfa Cymru - National Museum Wales website.

The table below shows the rainfall and temperature recorded by Model Church in Wales Primary School from November 2022 to March 2023.



The long term study...

Our climate and seasons are changing. Over the next 10-20 years (and hopefully longer) we want school scientists to show how climate change is affecting flowering dates for spring bulbs.

In the short term there is plenty for schools to study. This project is aimed at years 3 to 6 and draws on numeracy, literacy and digital skills. The project compliments elements of the national curriculum for Science, Geography, Maths, Art and ICT. It also supports the four purposes of the Curriculum for Wales by inspiring pupils to be confident, creative, ambitious and ethically informed.





UK & Wales Data



- Schools in Wales have been collecting data since 2005.
- Schools in England and Scotland have been collecting data since 2011.
- Schools in Northern Ireland have been collecting data since 2017.
- We have produced two summary reports. The first looks at data collected from across the UK 2011-2023 and compares readings from England, Scotland, Northern Ireland and Wales. The second looks at data collected from Wales 2005-2023.

Download the results yourself to...

- Make graphs and frequency charts to calculate the mean.
- See if flowers opened later in schools that recorded colder weather.

- See how temperature, sunshine and rainfall affect average flowering dates.
- Look for trends between different locations.
