SHEEP TRAIL

Black welsh mountain; I am the only completely black breed of sheep to be found in the UK. I am smaller than the other sheep and quite slender. I can survive on upland grazing and richer lowland grazing.



Hill Radnor; I am considered a rare breed . I am a hill breed, larger and bulkier than a welsh mountain breed. I have a thick white fleece and a tan face with a curved nose. Developed over the years to suit the Radnor Hills and is probably typical of the old Welsh tan-faced sheep that used to roam the hills. The breed remains very much confined to the Radnor/Brecon area of Wales and there are very few flocks in the rest of the U.K.

Llannwenog; I have a thick white fleece and distinct tuft or topknot above my head. Both my head and ears are black. I am able to survive in harsh upland areas as well as make the best use of richer lowland pastures.
