
Make a Saturnalia Star


You will need:


- Cardboard (we used empty cardboard boxes)
- Paper
- Pencil
- Plastic child-friendly needle
 - Ruler
 - Thread or ribbon
- Paint and paint brushes Child-friendly scissors (or an adult to cut)

Instructions:

1. Make a star template using your ruler, pencil and paper. We used two 8cm wide triangles to make the star, but you can choose your own size.

- Using the template, cut out some star shapes using the cardboard.
- 3. Use the plastic sewing needle to make a hole in the top of the star.
- Paint the star in a colour of your choice and add any patterns or decoration.
- 5. Let the paint dry.
- Thread a ribbon
 through the hole at the
 top and hang it on
 your Christmas tree.
