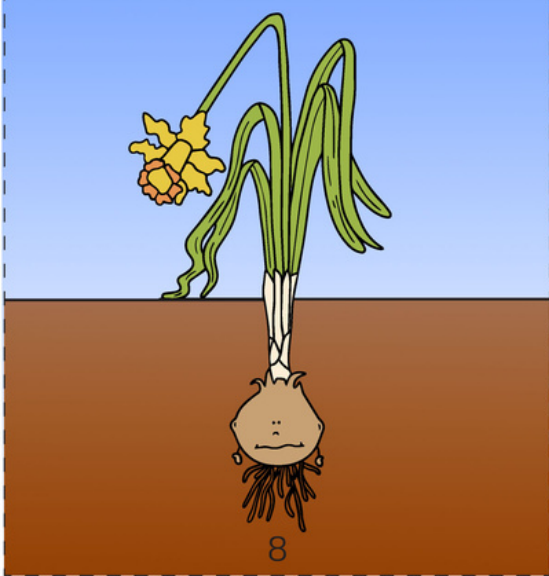




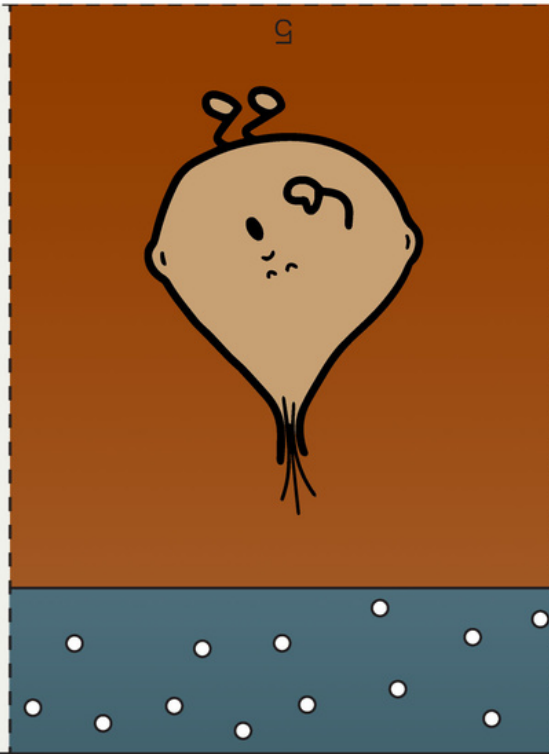
The new leaves make food and the flowers make seeds
