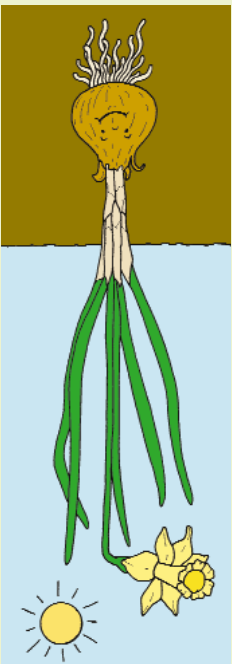
What do bulbs do

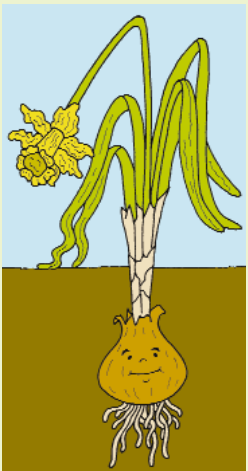

### At the end of Spring...

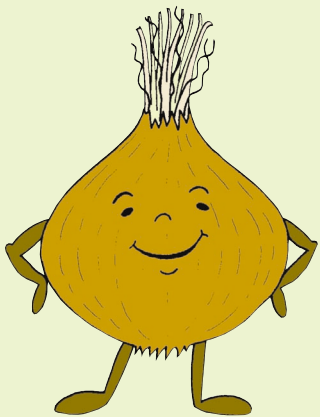
The plant

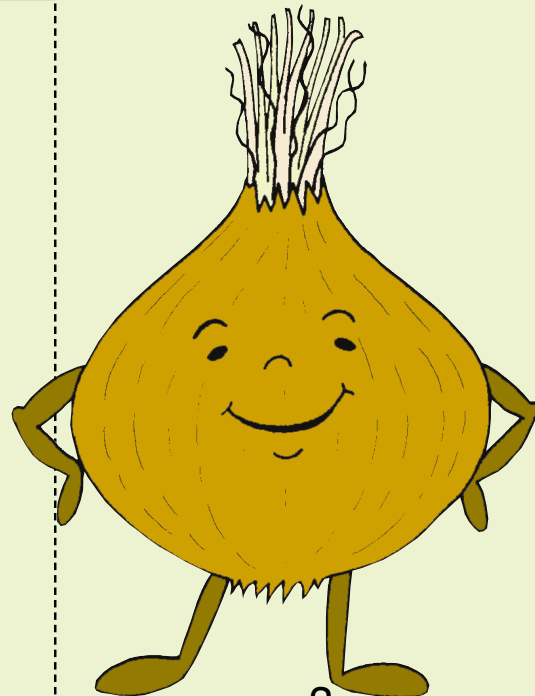
