## **National Slate Museum ESOL Entry 1 Fron Haul Quarrymen's Houses**

If you have previously done the activities on planning a visit, explain that these houses are part of the slate museum at Llanberis. If not, then ask general questions about museums the learners know: where are they, what can they see there etc. Some might not be familiar with this kind of museum. Explain simply what they can find at the slate museum, including houses to show how people lived in the past.

Look at the photo of the houses and ask for suggestions as to what they are like inside, what you might find there. Revise *there is/are* and what adjectives are.

Reading text: learners can work in pairs and take turns reading the text aloud to each other. They can find the answers to the activities together. Demonstrate the pronunciation of the Welsh place names and, if necessary, explain that the language works differently to English.

Depending on available equipment and learners' skills, you could use the 360 images from the museum website for this activity.
