Volunteering Activities

In the past, groups have helped us out with limewashing historic buildings, painting fences, farm work, gardening and even help organise archival materials.

If you have a particular type of activity in mind, please let us know. We will do our best to accommodate you, but we can't guarantee that activity will be possible.

Training and Supervision

Your group will receive useful and appropriate induction, training, support and Amgueddfa Cymru staff supervision. We will also provide all PPE needed free of charge.

Your organisation will need to nominate a Team Leader who will offer support and a level of supervision of your organisation's group.

Organisations/Charities will need to bring the appropriate ratio of supervisors and/or carers to supervise groups with additional needs.

Minimum group size

To ensure there are enough helping hands to complete the activities there is a minimum requirement of 8 people per group.

Participants Age Group

Participants must be over 16 years old to take part. We will undertake additional risk assessments of each activity for participants who are 16 – 18 years old.

Timetable for the day

Typical timetable:

10.00am	Arrival at Tŷ Gwyrdd.
10.30am	Welcome talk and briefing. Split into groups (if necessary). Volunteer.
1.30pm	Lunch break
2.30pm	Optional activities or free time.
3.30pm	End.

Refreshments and Lunch

We have cafes across the Museum which you are more than welcome to use throughout your day with us. Groups receive 20% discount in all of our cafes.

Alternatively, you can order catering to provide breakfast, refreshments and/or lunch alongside room hire (more information below).

Your group can also bring packed lunches which you can eat outside across the Museum. We can offer you Tŷ Gwyrdd as a base, which people are more than welcome to use for lunch as well. This space is open to all staff and volunteers, and you will have people going in and out.
