

The Vulcan – Visitor FAQs

What type of drinks will The Vulcan serve?

The Vulcan will serve a selection of period appropriate drinks including beers brewed by Glamorgan Brewing Company. There will be non-alcoholic options and soft drinks available.

How much does a pint cost?

A pint costs £5.50.

Will I only be able to have one drink?

No, visitors won't be limited to one drink, but we ask that you drink responsibly. We reserve the right to refuse service to anyone who is drunk or disorderly.

Can I pre-book a seat in The Vulcan?

You can guarantee a seat in the pub by pre-booking a beer flight or a traditional lemonade. You can book this via our website: [Events at the Vulcan \(museum.wales\)](https://www.museum.wales/events-at-the-vulcan)

Can I just turn up?

Yes, you can visit The Vulcan without pre-booking. We are expecting that the pub will be very busy for the first few months, and you will need to queue to gain entry.

How long can I stay in The Vulcan?

If you have booked a beer flight, this guarantees you a seat for an hour. There is no time limit on how long you can stay in the pub, but we do ask that you are considerate to other visitors and don't stay in the pub all day. We are expecting to be very busy during the first few months and you can help us ensure that more visitors can experience this unique 1915 pub by not propping up the bar for too long!

What are The Vulcan opening hours?

The Vulcan will be open during normal museum operating hours of 10am-5pm.

Can I hire The Vulcan for an event?

Are dogs allowed?

As The Vulcan is a historic building, dogs are not allowed in the pub. They are welcome to explore the outside areas of the museum on a short lead.

Why can't I take my pram/buggy into the pub?

As with many historic buildings on site at St Fagans, there simply isn't enough room to accommodate prams and buggies. We do allow prams into the larger buildings of Llys Llywelyn and St Teilo's Church.

Can children visit The Vulcan?

Children are welcome to visit The Vulcan in the company of an adult.

Why aren't you selling cask beer?

We are working with Glamorgan Brewing Co. to supply the beer for The Vulcan. The beer will be keg, not cask, as we're unable to guarantee how much beer we will need. Cask has a shorter shelf life once it is opened and to reduce wastage, we have opted for keg. We know people feel strongly about cask ales and we will review this decision over the next few months once we have more data about how the pub operates and how much beer we sell.

Why aren't you selling Brains beer?

Brains did not submit a tender to supply beer for The Vulcan at St Fagans.

Can I smoke in the pub or the beer garden?

The Museum is a no smoking site. Smoking and vaping is not allowed anywhere on site including in the outdoor areas.

Does The Vulcan serve food?

A range of bar snacks are available.

Can I bring my own food into the pub?

No. Only food purchased in The Vulcan can be consumed in the pub.

Does the pub have toilets?

Yes, there are toilets at the back of The Vulcan.

How accessible is the pub for wheelchair users?

The Vulcan is wheelchair accessible. There is step free level access to the building. It is a small building so parts of it are quite confined, but doorways have been widened to ensure access and the main bar has plenty of open floor space. It also has an accessible bathroom.
