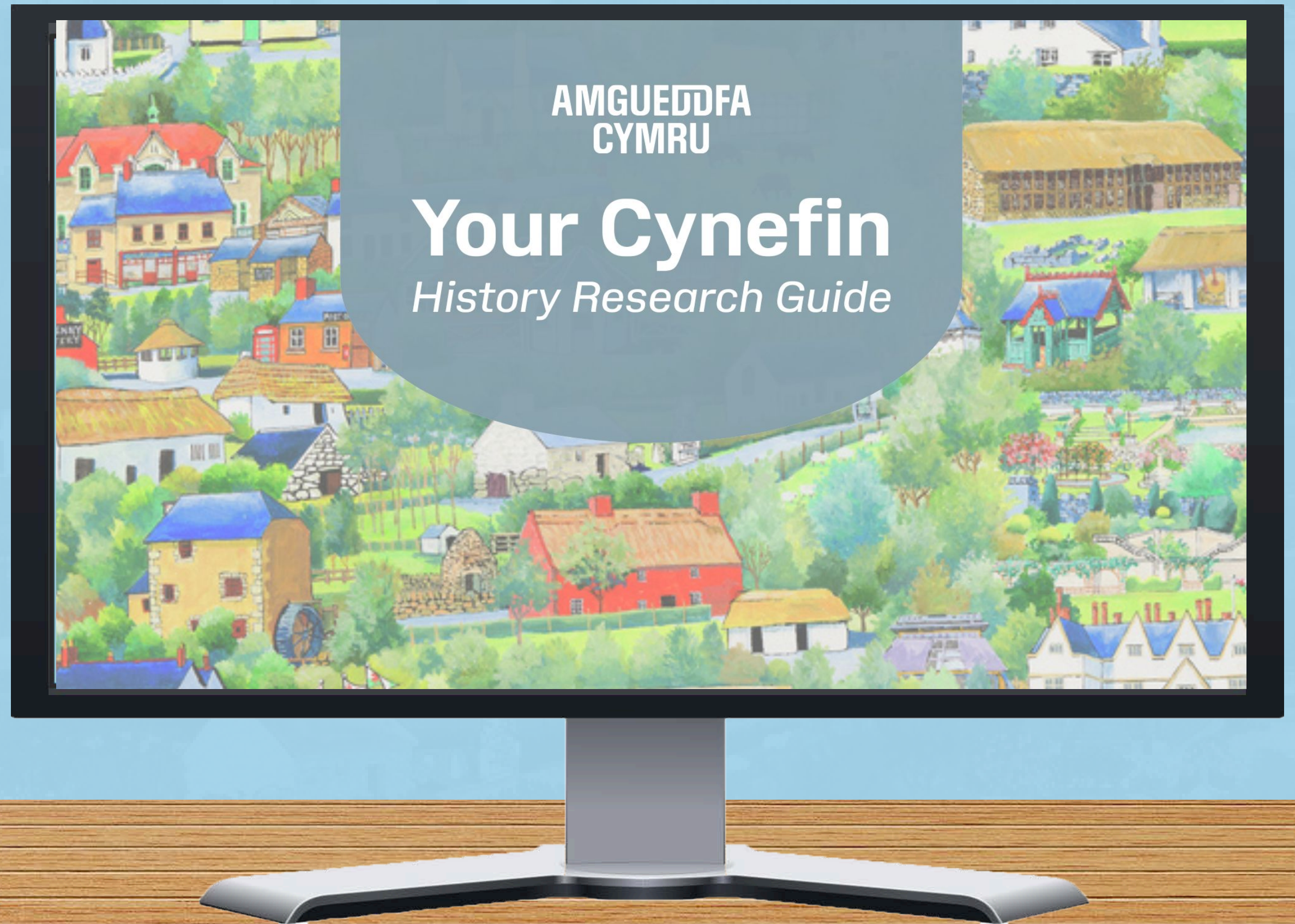

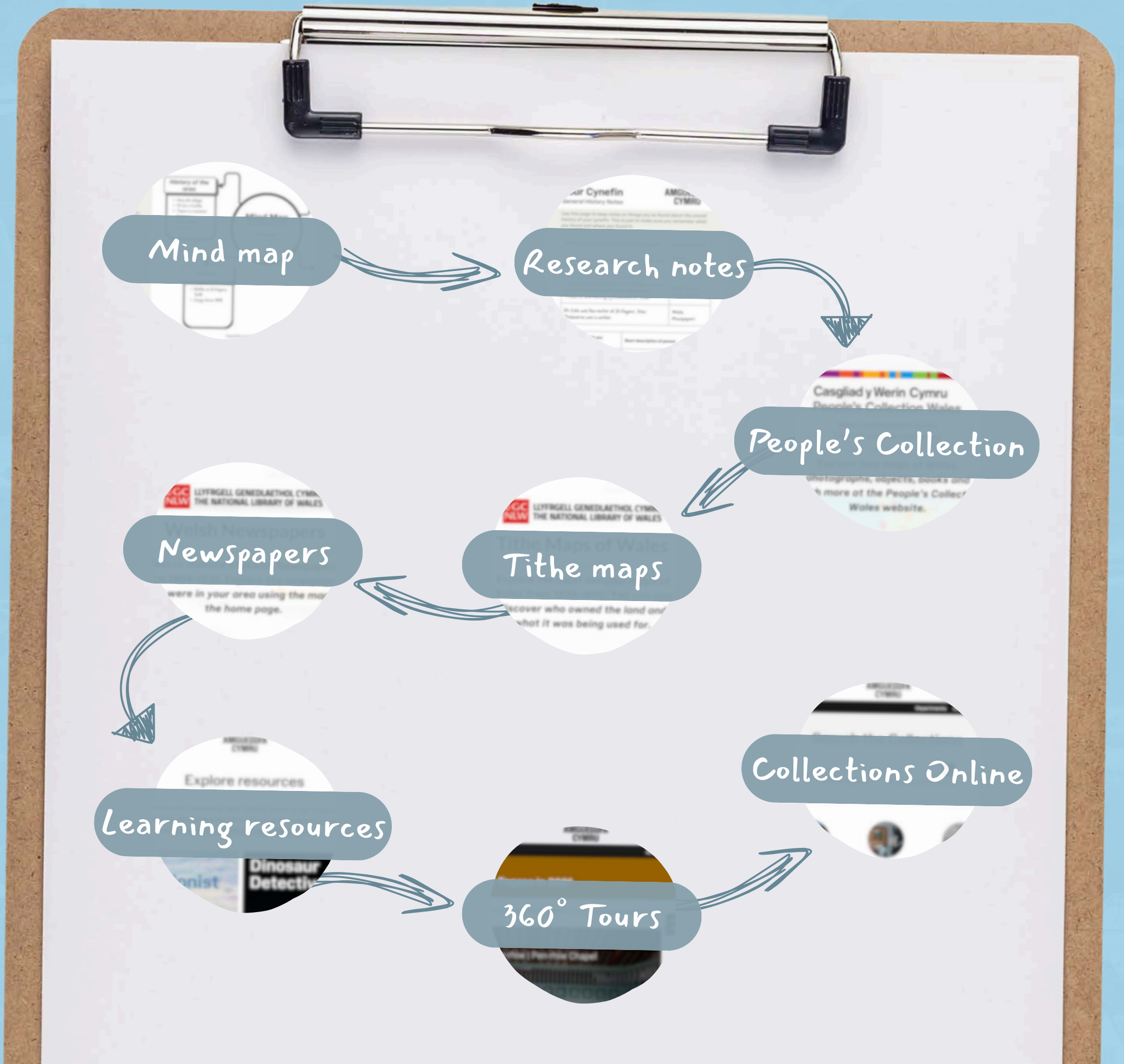

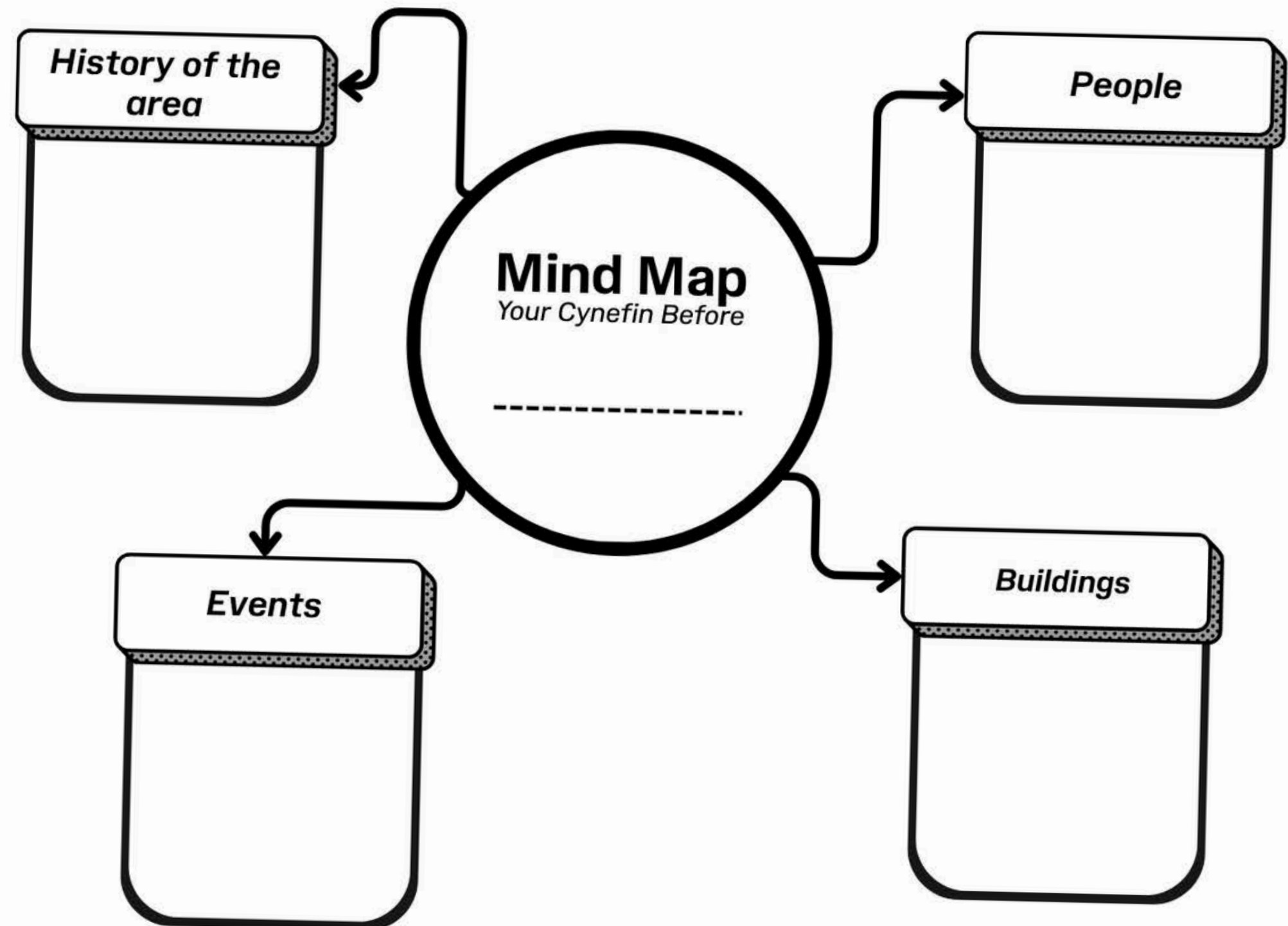

A good way to start your research is to list what you already know. Download our mind map template and fill it out.

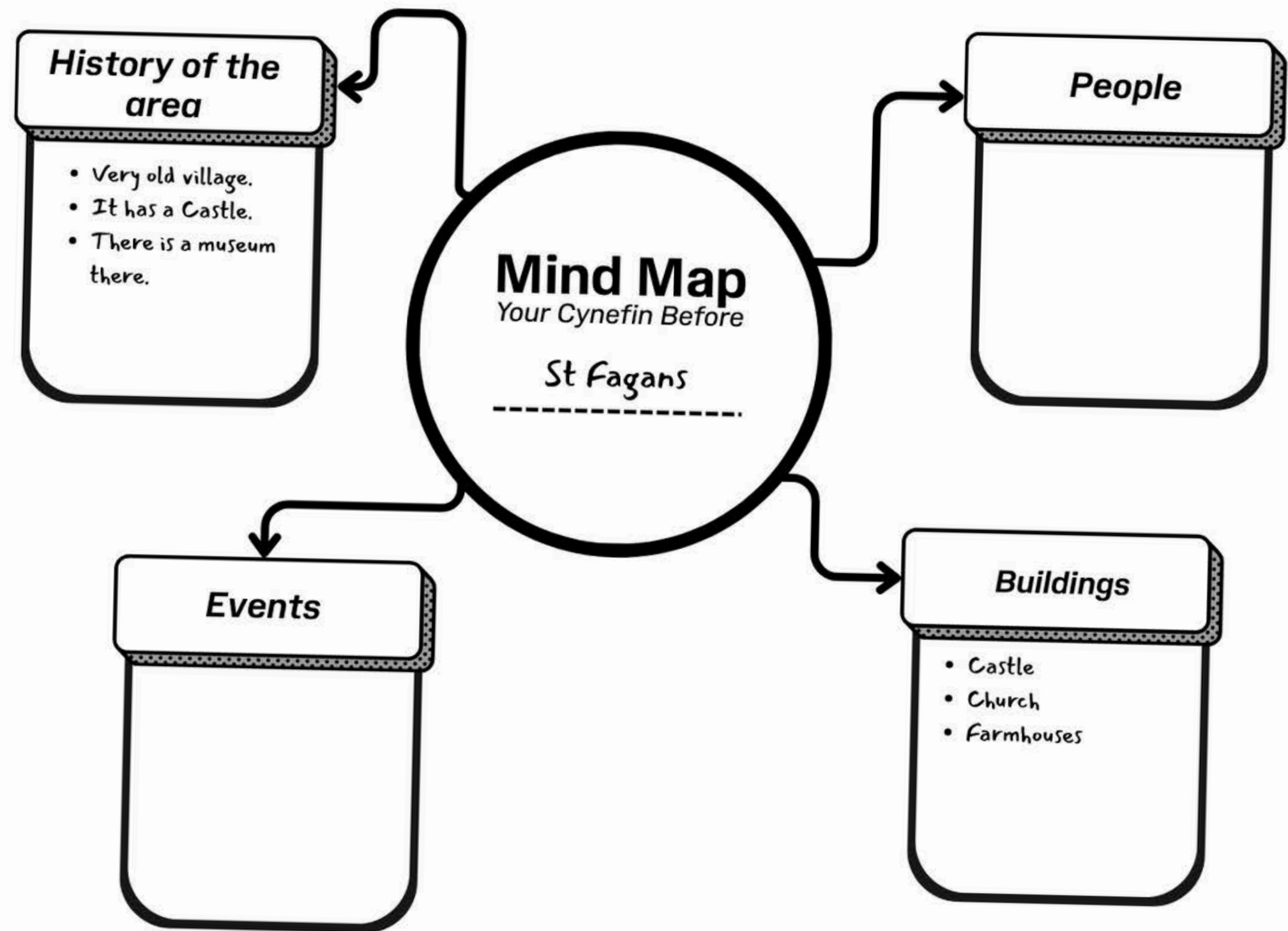

This is one we filled in before our St Fagans research began. You may only fill out one section at first and that is fine.



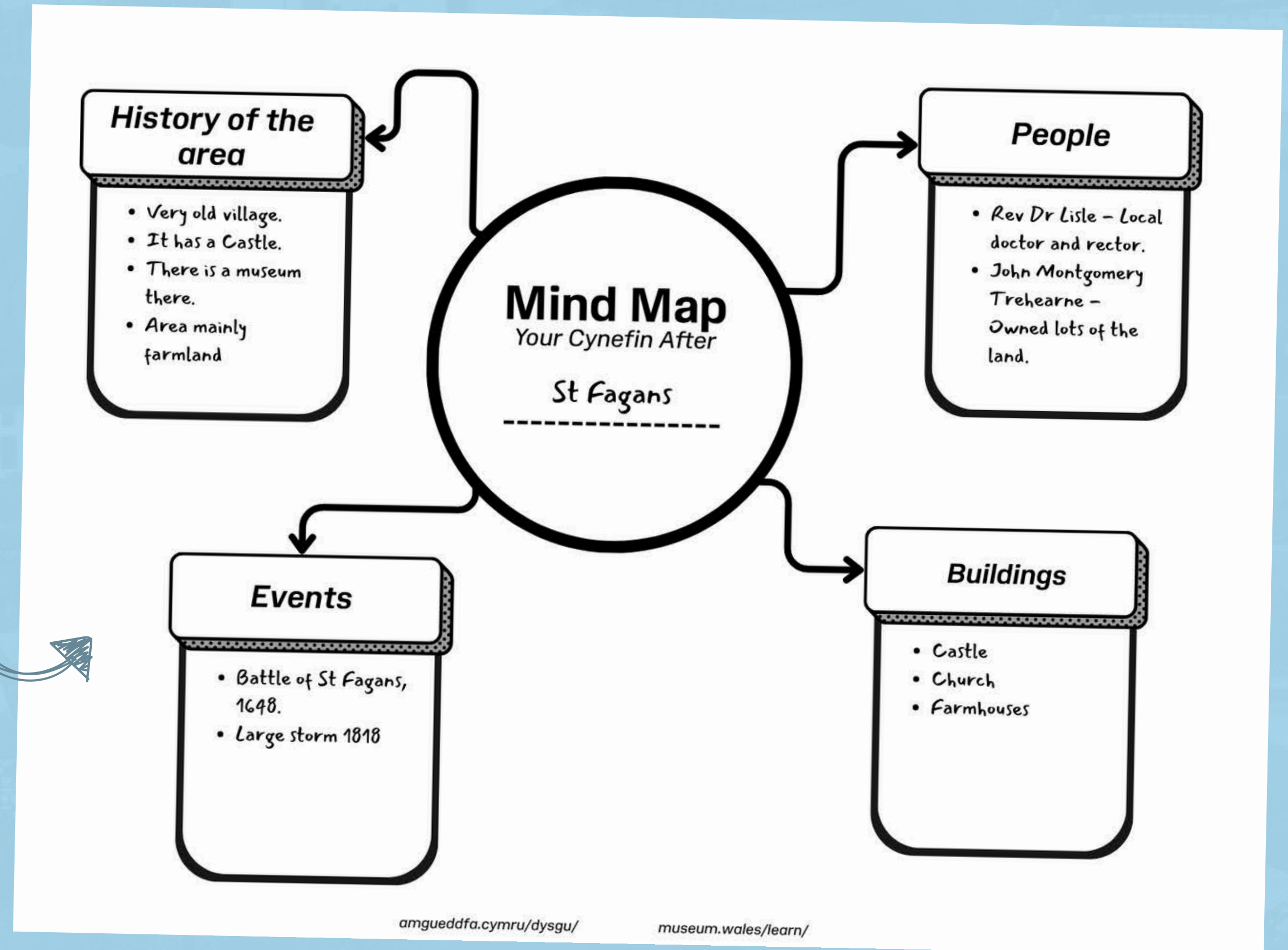
