We will be co-creating of a temporary display at the National Roman Legion Museum (NRLM) exploring flooding, climate change, and long-term human interaction with the Gwent Levels.

We will work collaboratively with museum staff to help select and interpret archaeological objects and digital content. Embedding stories of climate change, heritage, and environmental adaptation at the National Roman Legion Museum for the first time.

This project is sponsored by the National Lottery Heritage Fund and draws on the important work of the Living Levels partnership.

What we'll be doing

- guided visits to National Museum Cardiff and NRLM to explore collections
- work with curators to help select objects linked to the Gwent Levels
- contribute ideas and perspectives to the interpretation of objects and themes
- co-create short pieces of interpretive content (e.g. labels, quotes, digital content)
- help shape the selection of digital materials from the Living Levels archive
- provide feedback on display design and visitor experience
- support social media or launch activity (tbc)
